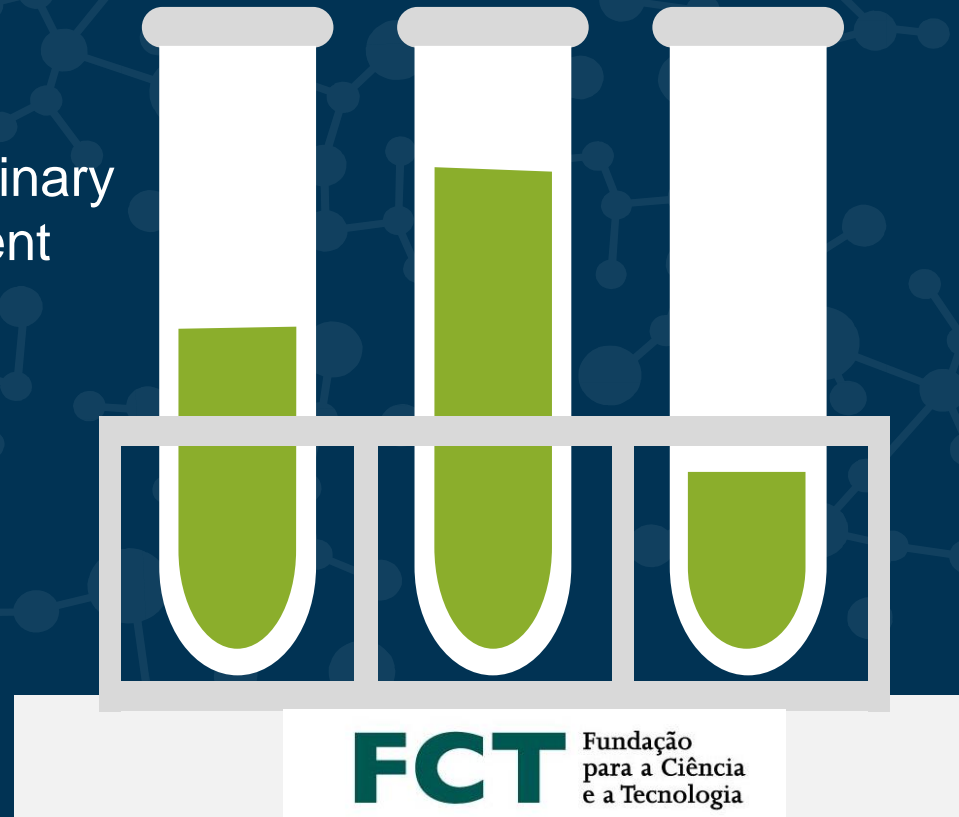

Water management
