



# Potential collaboration on research teams

#### Water management

Natural renewable water resources are very limited in the Mediterranean region and there is an increasing pressure on the resource available. By the other side, a reduction of rainfall is expected due to climatic change and subsurface resources are very threatened by over exploitation, contamination and saline intrusion.
